Entries

Entries are £40 per individual and £75 per team online at <http://www.britishfencing.com/events/competition-entry/> Club affiliation will be drawn from BF membership database. To avoid delay entrants should check that their club is correctly recorded on their membership profile by logging on at <http://www.britishfencing.com/signin/>. Team entries will also be via the competition entries website, but must be made by one individual on behalf of the team. Once the entry has been made, confirmation of team name must be sent as soon as possible to Katie Dolan at events@britishfencing.com (please see below for information on providing names of team members). An entry list for teams will be updated regularly on the British Fencing website.

Closing date: Midnight, Sunday 24th November 2013. Late entries will be accepted at double entry fee at the organisers discretion until Midnight, Sunday 1st December 2013.

Eligibility: Fencers must be current members of British Fencing. The Championship is open to all those holding British nationality and those holding dual nationality provided they do not hold an FIE international licence issued by a country other than Great Britain

The 2013 Beazley British Individual Championships will be run with one round of poules, 30% cut then Direct Elimination

Please note that there is no cap on entries for the 2013 Beazley British Championships, however should this become necessary closer to the closing date, an announcement will be made on the British Fencing website.

Seeding will be on the 1st December rankings.

Team competitions will operate with pools and DE. There will be even pools of 3 or 4 with a small number of teams having a bye to the DE where necessary. Every member of the team must belong to the same established club and that club must be registered with British Fencing. Normally the club would be that identified by the fencer on their BF membership record, but you are asked to confirm this by email as per information above.

All team fencers must be identified by the closing date but amendments can be accepted up to, at the latest, 12 noon on 7th December. Any substituted fencers must be members of the same club. There can be no change to team composition after this time. Amendments will be accepted in writing at EIS on 7th December but, if submitting by e-mail, must be received by events@britishfencing.com before 6pm on Thursday 5th December.

All fencers must be members of British Fencing and each team may have a maximum of 1 fencer who does not hold British Nationality.
