### **Notes:**

Eligibility - Fencers must be current members of British Fencing. The Championship is open to all those holding British nationality and those holding dual nationality provided they do not hold an FIE international licence issued by a country other than Great Britain

Juniors – under 20 and over 13 on 1st January 2014, i.e. born between 1/1994 and 12/2000 inc.

Cadets – under 17 and over 11 on 1st January 2014, i.e. born between 1/1997 and 12/2002 inc.

Only one event may be entered each day.

Format will be one round of poules with a 20% cut before DE

Providing they meet the age requirements above there is no restriction on Cadets entering the Junior Championships.

Medals will be awarded to the top four in each event.

All fencers and spectators participate at their own risk, and are personally responsible for their own safety. Spectators are admitted to the venue, and entries accepted, on the understanding that British Fencing, the organising committee, officials, referees and staff of Sportsdock cannot accept responsibility for accidents, loss or damage to persons or property, however caused.
