The 2016/17 Cadet & Junior British Championships will be managed by Katie Rhodes, British Fencing Events Manager, with Jon Willis from Leon Paul coordinating the running of the competition on the day.

This event forms part of the qualifying events for the Cadet & Junior teams for 2017 – therefore the upper age limits are based on being aged under 17 or under 20 on 1st January 2017.

Eligibility

Fencers must be current members of British Fencing. Junior British Championships are only open to those holding British Nationality, including those holding multiple nationalities, provided the fencer does not hold an FIE license issued for a country other than Great Britain.

Eligibility for Cadet British Championships will be as above, however, if a fencer holds an EFC license for another country they may still compete at the British Championships as long as they are eligible by nationality. As soon as a cadet fencer applies for an FIE licence for a country other than GBR they will no longer be eligible to compete at the British Championships.

Juniors – under 20 on 1st January 2017 and over 13 on 1st January 2016, i.e. born 1997 - 2002

Cadets – under 17 on 1st January 2017 and over 11 on 1st January 2016, i.e. born 2000 – 2004

Only one event may be entered each day.

Providing they meet the age requirements above there is no restriction on Cadets entering the Junior Championships.

Format:

1 rounds of poules with a cut before Direct Elimination.

Entries:

Entry fee is £35 per event. Entries will be taken via the Sport80 system at www.bf.sport80.com. If you have any problems entering, please contact support@sport80.com in the first instance.

Club Information:

Fencers should confirm their club is up to date on their membership profile before entering, as no changes will be allowed on the day of the competition.

Equipment: All fencers must wear correct kit as per British Fencing rules. This includes 800N plastrons & 800N sabre gloves as per the rule at <http://www.britishfencing.com/news/latest-news/?n=841>

Leon Paul and England Fencing will be providing the equipment for the event. All pistes will be conductive.

There will be a Leon Paul stand at the event - if you are hoping to buy something specific, it is recommended you contact them in advance to ensure they bring the item with them.

Venue info: There is plenty of parking at the venue – the sports centre car park will be for members of the centre only, however the university car park will be open and manned throughout the weekend.

There is plenty of space for spectators at the venue, as well as banked seating.

There is a café at SportsDock, and vending machines.

Medical: There will be paramedics at the event throughout, as well as a doctor and/or physio present each day. They will be seated in the stands in an area clearly marked as MEDICAL

Welfare: There will be a dedicated welfare officer at the event who will be clearly visible throughout.
