ENTRIES

Entries, £35 individual and £60 per team online at <http://www.britishfencing.com/events/competition-entry/>

Closing date: Midnight, Sunday 16th September 2012. Late entries will be accepted at double entry fee at the organisers discretion until Midnight, Sunday 23rd September 2012.

Eligibility: Fencers must be current members of British Fencing. The Championship is open to all those holding British nationality and those holding dual nationality provided they do not hold an FIE international licence issued by a country other than Great Britain

In Men's Epee, Men's Foil, Men's Sabre and Women's Epee, individual entry is limited to 91 with the top 50 in the September 1st rankings being guaranteed a place provided they enter by the closing date. The remaining places will be allocated in order of entry. For Women's Foil and Women's Sabre the limit will be 63, with the top 35 being guaranteed entry. These limits will be reviewed following the closing date and any adjustments notified.

There will be a single round of poules followed by a 30% cut. Seeding will be on the 1st October ranking.

Team competitions will operate with pools and DE. There will be even pools of 3 or 4 with a small number of teams having a bye to the DE where necessary.

Only clubs registered with British Fencing can enter the Team Competition. Team names must be entered by the closing date and the names of those fencing notified by, at the latest, 3pm on 6th October. There can be no change to team composition after this time and teams not identifying fencers by that time will be scratched. Fencer's names will be accepted in writing at EIS on 6th October before 3pm but, if submitting by e-mail, must be received by events@britishfencing.com before 6pm on Thursday 4th October.

All fencers must be members of British Fencing and each team may have a maximum of 1 fencer who does not hold British Nationality.
