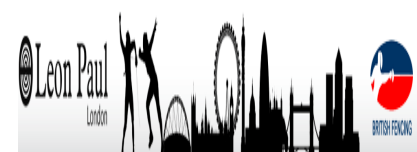

Competition format and kit requirements

- One round of pools (normally 6 or 7 fencers) followed by DE to 10 hits for U11 and U13, or DE to 15 hits for U15.
- Weapons sizes: U11 and U13 must use size 3 foils and size 2 epees or sabres. U15 may use size 5 or smaller.
- Plastrons are mandatory – 350N for U11 or U13, 800N for U15.
- Conductive bibs are required for U15 Foil only.
- Weight and gauge testing will take place on the piste. Cards will be issued for failed weapons/wires, or for not having a spare if required.

Eligibility and Entry Caps

All entrants must be members of England Fencing Ltd.

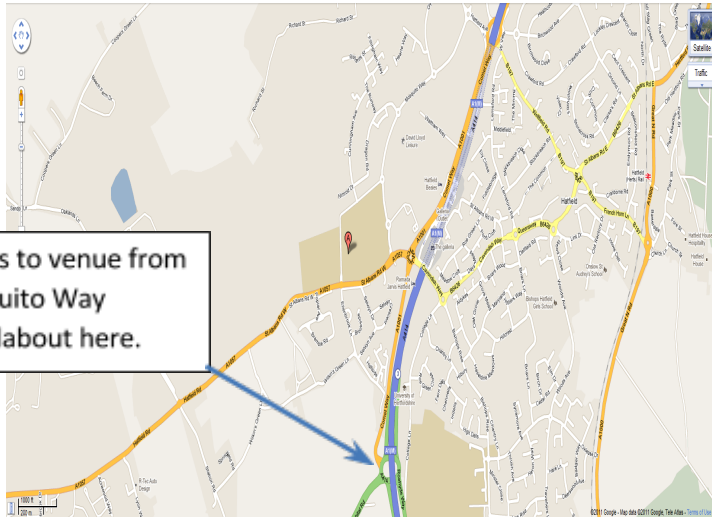
Entrants must be born in 2000 or 2001 to enter U15 categories, born in 2002 or 2003 to enter U13 categories, or born in 2004, 2005 or 2006 to enter U11 categories. We regret that we are unable to accept entries from fencers born 2007 or later.

The competition is frequently over-subscribed, and entry caps will be enforced (see table). Entries received in excess of the cap will be placed on a reserve list. In the last two weeks before the event, the organisers reserve the right to alter the caps to take account of entries received in each weapon/age/gender. **The smooth running of the event will take higher priority than accommodating late entrants, so please get your entries in early!** Any changes to the caps will be posted at www.Englandfencing.org.uk.

Prizes and Medals

Medals will be awarded for the top 4 places in each event. If you won a trophy last year, please don't forget to have it engraved and returned in time for this year's event.

There may also be awards for technical merit. These will be awarded to the fencer who, in the opinion of the judges, demonstrates the best technique.

EYC results may also be used for direct selection to England Fencing Squads taken to foreign competitions. Criteria vary by year and by weapon – please see the England Fencing website for current information.
