British Fencers are asked to enter via the Sport80 website (bf.sport80.co.uk) – all fencers ranked in the top 50 of the GB Cadet Sabre rankings on 1st October will be guaranteed entry. Those ranked outside the top 50 may still enter, but their place will not be guaranteed until after the closing date at the discretion of the organisers.
