British U10 Foil Championship Sunday 19 May 2013

In the 19th Century Dr William Penny Brookes instigated an Olympian Games for the people of Much Wenlock and the surrounding area. Pierre de Coubertin visited and used the principles behind this event to start the Modern Olympics. The links between Much Wenlock, the modern Olympian Movement and Greece continues today and was used as part of the London bid for 2012. In the town are several places of interest including the Museum where there is a display of Olympic memorabilia

This competition is open to all British fencers born 2003/2004. There will be separate events for girls and boys, insulated pistes and tower lights will be on all pistes. **NB** It is highly likely that people will want to take photographs at this event. Anyone wishing to do so must sign in at registration, please contact the organiser if you have any concerns about this. All Participants and their supporters must comply with British Fencing Codes of Conduct at all times. The fees have risen substantially this year to cover fees levied by British Fencing and payments that will be made to referees.

NB: BF clothing regulations will be enforced, including breeches, plastrons and long socks. Foils will be weight tested throughout the competition. Size 'O' blades must be used.
