Men's Foil FIE Satellite Event



BRITISH FENCING

The Leon Paul Cup is open to all male foilists, both foreign and British nationals possessing a current FIE Licence. This event is appointed by the FIE as a satellite World Cup tournament. The final 8 will be awarded World Cup points. This event has also been selected by the EFC as a nominated event for seeding the U23 European Championships.

Please note: the venue is in east London. Transport to central London (Oxford Circus) takes 50 minutes by underground train.

- 1) **Date:** Sunday 2nd December 2012
- 2) **Venue:** Redbridge Sports Centre,
Forest Road,
Barkingside,
Ilford,
IG6 3HD.

The nearest station is Fairlop (Central underground line).

If coming from London Heathrow airport: take the Piccadilly underground line to Holborn and change on to the Central Line (eastbound trains to Hainault).

If coming from London Stansted airport: take the Stansted Express train to London Liverpool Street station and change there to the Central underground line (eastbound trains to Hainault).

If coming from London Gatwick airport: take the Gatwick Express train to London Victoria station and change there to the District underground line (eastbound to Upminster). Change at Mile End to the Central Line (eastbound trains to Hainault).

Non-GBR entries: must be made through the FIE by their National Federation in accordance with FIE rules (o54).

- 5) **Entry Fee:** The entry fee is £24.00 or €30.
- 6) **Formula:** The competition will be fenced according to the official FIE formula.
- 7) **Programme:** Weapon Control:
Friday 30th November: 18.00-21.00 at the venue.
Saturday 1st December: 10.00-16.30 at the venue.

- 8) **Doping:** Control will be carried out.
- 9) **Publicity:** The FIE Publicity Code will be strictly enforced.
- 10) **FIE Rules:** The Competition will run in accordance with the FIE Rules for Competitions. The Directoire Technique will, however, reserve the right to decide, without right of appeal, on any issues not covered by the FIE Rules or by these Rules.
- 11) **Referees:** Each country is required to send FIE qualified referees in accordance with FIE rule o.81. Official candidates for FIE refereeing exams may also referee provided they hold a **current** FIE Fencer's licence (Rule t.35). The names of referees, together with their FIE Category, must be emailed to British Fencing (headoffice@britishfencing.com) 15 days before the event. (With 5-9 fencers 1 referee must be sent, 10 or more fencers requires 2 referees to be sent.)
- 12) **Accommodation: Booking accommodation is the responsibility of the visiting teams. British Fencing cannot book hotels for delegations.**

The nearest hotel to the venue is the Holiday Inn Express, Newbury Park.
