

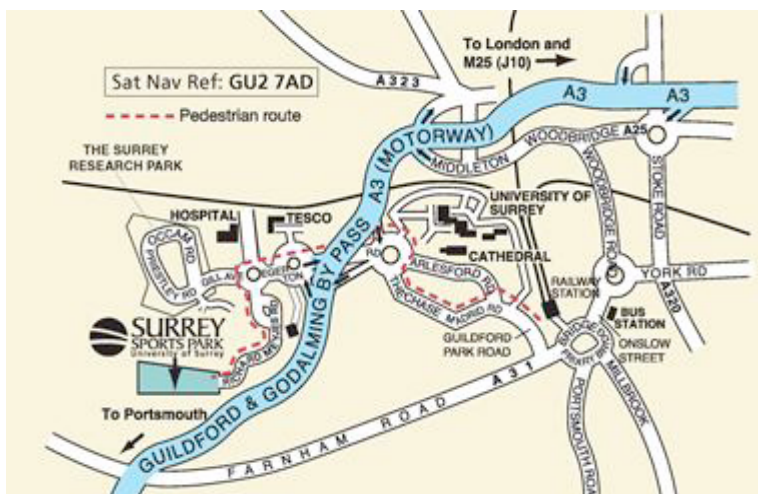

- 4) **GBR entries:** The top 6 in the Senior British Ranking have automatic selection. In addition, places are available for discretionary selection and to fencers ranked in the top 20 of the December 2012 Senior Rankings up to a maximum of 20 fencers. Please confirm your participation to headoffice@britishfencing.com by 10th January. Please also note that FIE rules will apply to withdrawal from the competition.
- 5) **Entry Fee:** The entry fee of €60.00 or £50.00 must be paid on arrival at the competition venue. The check-

- 9) **Publicity:** The FIE Publicity Code will be strictly enforced.
- 10) **FIE Rules:** The Competition will run in accordance with the FIE Rules for Competitions.
- 11) **Referees:** Referees will be designated by the FIE and British Fencing. Countries are not required to provide referees.
- 12) **Accommodation: Booking accommodation is the responsibility of the visiting teams. British Fencing cannot book hotels for delegations.**

- 13) Airport Transfers:** Sportworks can provide airport transfers from London Heathrow, London Luton, London Stansted, London City and London Gatwick. Teams will be charged for transfers and quotes will be provided based on numbers and timings. Please contact Gary for a quotation.
- 14) Event Transport:** Coaches (depending on numbers) will depart from the Radisson Blu Edwardian Hotel to the Surrey Sports Park each morning. They will depart Surrey Sports Park each evening to return competitors to the Radisson Blu Edwardian Hotel. Timings to suit competition schedule will be published in the hotel foyer. The cost for this service is included in the hotel rates above.
- 15) General Transport:** Should you choose to travel by train there are numerous taxi companies available but where it's possible Sportworks will pick up and drop off at Guildford Rail Station. This service is not guaranteed.
